The Council of the Haida Nation's Haida Fisheries Program is seeking a full-time contract Fisheries Biologist. The focus will be on salmon stock assessment and management. Preference will be given to applicants with the following education and experience:

- B.Sc. in Biology with two or more years of fisheries related experience and knowledge of salmonid stock assessment projects.
- Fisheries stock assessment project design, statistical analysis and report preparation.
- Project management experience including preparation of proposals, budgets and work plans as well as cost control and staff supervision.
- Experience working with First Nation's organizations.
- Operating small vessels and working in isolated settings (field camps or aboard vessels).
- Proven leadership and interpersonal skills and ability to supervise field crews while fostering a team based approach.

General Duties include management of field projects, supervision and training of field staff, biological support for a recreational creel program and large-scale salmon hatchery as well as preparation of technical reports.
