SITUATION UPDATE

The 3 main situations that the EOC is responding to this week is:

1) Family Interaction and expanding our family bubble

-How to talk to family and children about COVID-19 risks on Haida Gwaii and how we need to stay safe as families as we expand our visiting over the next couple of weeks

2) Islanders returning from off-island

-How to take isolation seriously and stay away from public spaces and within a 6-8 feet distance from people.

3) Marina traffic and safety

-When boaters return to the dock and into community.

*The EOC receives incident reports and concerns from community members regarding risks and feelings of being unsafe. We take these concerns and weave them into our safety planning for the community and also advocate for adjustments in the extended Haida Gwaii Communities.

Reminders for us all

⇒ Keep washing your hands as much as possible

⇒ Keep physically distanced from people outside the home

⇒ Do not go into public places such as grocery stores when you have travelled off-island in the last 14 days. Let the EOC know of your isolation plans and what would make isolating easier.
