



HAIDA GWAI STATE OF EMERGENCY

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 29, 2021

This bulletin is a temporary amendment to the October 2, 2020 State of Emergency, which remains in full effect.

KEEP YOUR CIRCLE SMALL

- Pull back your social circle to include only people you live with.
- Parties and gatherings are not permitted at this time.

RESPECT PHYSICAL DISTANCING & PRACTICE GOOD HYGIENE

- If you absolutely need to leave your home: wear a mask, physical distance, wash your hands, avoid touching your face and mask.
- Ensure physical distancing, even when enjoying outdoor spaces.
- Travel between Island communities should be kept to essential errands only. Additional measures may be in place through local EOCs.

TRAVEL TO/FROM HAIDA GWAI

- **Only essential travel** is permitted to/from Haida Gwaii.
- Essential workers must apply through the CHN website and receive an approval before arrival.
- Do not travel off-Island unless essential. For example, “essential” includes medical travel, which is important and encouraged. It also includes urgent family matters and essential work off-Island.
- Residents **must isolate for 14 days** when returning from travel off-Island

Emergency measures will be re-evaluated regularly and further updates will be posted as needed. Go to <haidanation.ca>
